Hopkins House currently operates a preschool academy for children from low-income, working families; offers family education services including financial literacy workshops, computer training and family health outreach; and, provides financial assistance to families with children tragically affected by violent crime.

Hopkins House also advocates on matters of public policy affecting children and families.

The organization is guided in its mission by the Community Stakeholders of the Hopkins House Association.
