Through a grant from the Early Childhood Collaborative and other financiers, and in collaboration with Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA), Hopkins House now offers college classes, child care, and career guidance to individuals interested in a career in Early Childhood Education. Cost to the student is a \$50 registration & activity fee and a \$200 tuition fee, per semester.

Open to the public, program participants can earn a CDA credential, two Child Development Certificates, and up to 31 college credits (out of 67 needed for an AA degree) in two years. Upon successful completion of the program, participants are *guaranteed* a salary of \$25,000 or more, plus benefits, if employed by a local, participating childcare center in the City of Alexandria or Fairfax County.
