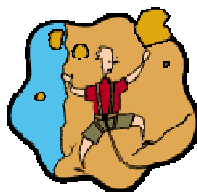


- How many sides does a box have?

July 12 - July 23



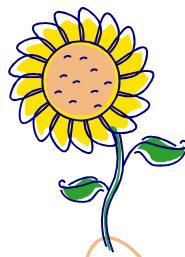
- Where do rocks come from?

July 26 - August 6

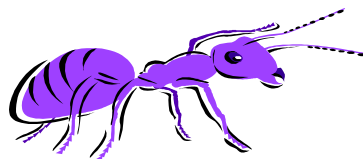


- Where do flowers come from?
